A letter from the co-founders

True cybersecurity begins with a state of mind.

We saw early that it didn't matter if you were young or old, skilled with the command line, or just figuring out which icon starts the browser. It didn't matter what you were doing online. Everyone just wanted to feel safe. Confident. Private. After all, this is what the early internet days promised us. So this is what we set out to deliver.

It was a simple idea.

We wanted to make digital tools that could offer plenty to security professionals and still be intuitive enough to use for their grandparents. In other words, we started building a radically better internet.

But that is a tall order for just a couple of geeks, however high they aim. So we went looking for people who could have a real shot at making the internet better. The ones who were striving to be actual inventors. The ones thriving to disrupt. And the ones that were fun to have around.

- We sat in the interviews until the company grew too big to attend them all.
- We made a tradition of regular town hall meetings and answering all questions. Even about why one of us is bald and the other is not.
- **We would have breakfast with our newbies, introduce Nord's vision and show how informal talks can make all the difference in the world. Or in reaching OKRs.**

All this culture building continues to pay off. Last year Nord Security was named one of the Best Places to Work 2023 in Germany by Glassdoor, showing that our inner culture is on the right path.

Nord Security is not a typical cybersecurity company. But it is aligned with other mindful companies aiming to bring positive change. So we are proud to share our 2022 Nord Security Impact report. It contains what Nord's teams worked on over the past year to advance our mission to build a radically better internet and positively impact people, communities, and the environment:

Supporting the people in Ukraine and the most vulnerable around the world. Last year Nord Security's products put significant effort into cooperating with NGOs and organizations fighting for human rights. We are also proud of our entire global community's unity and readiness to act in supporting Ukraine's people against Russia's invasion including donations and volunteering.

Strategic priorities to make a positive ESG impact. Customers are our most important stakeholders. So in 2022 the company redefined ways to bring even more value to its users, shareholders, affected communities, and the stakeholders of the sustainable, open, and secure internet.

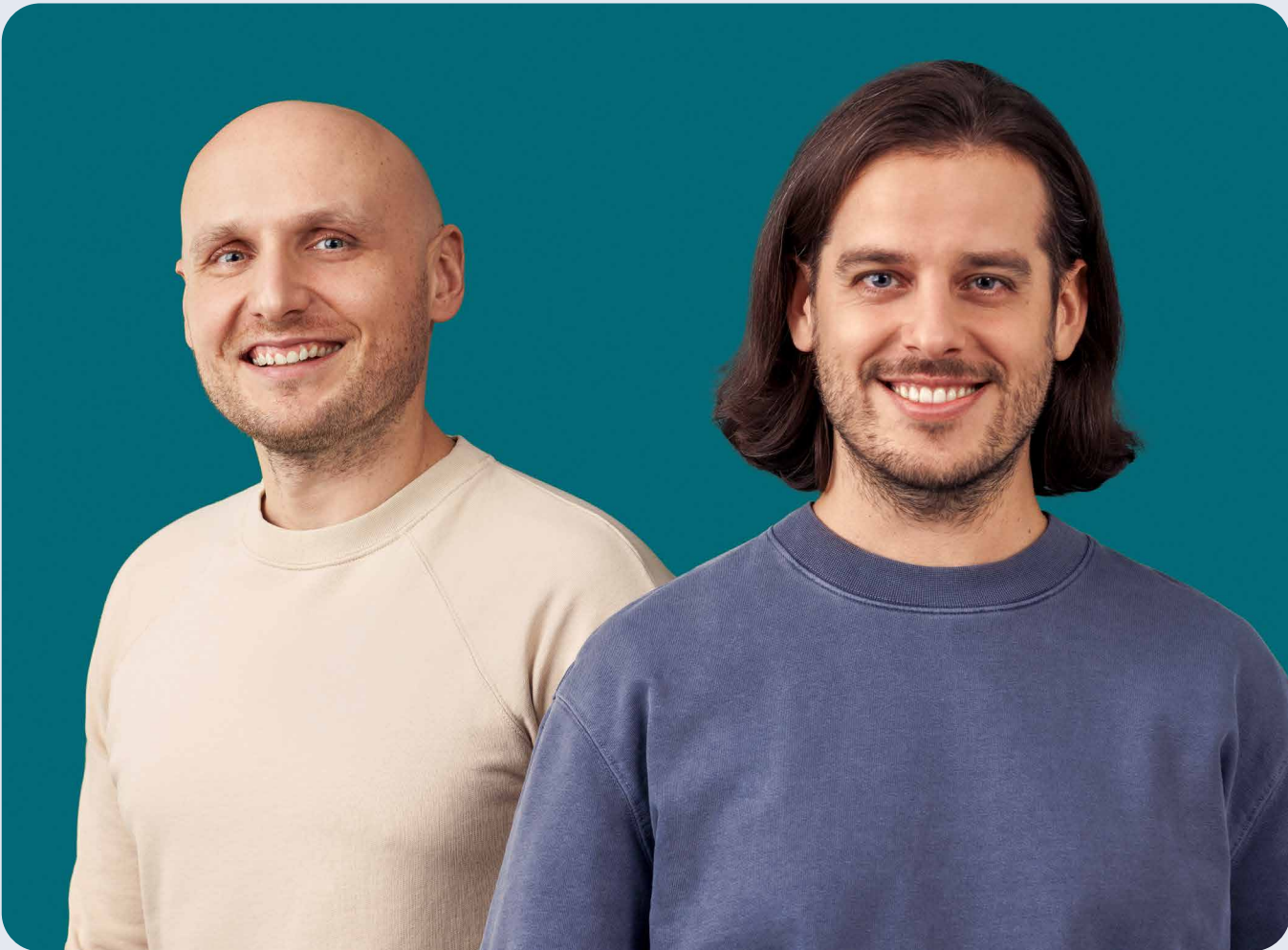

About the impact report

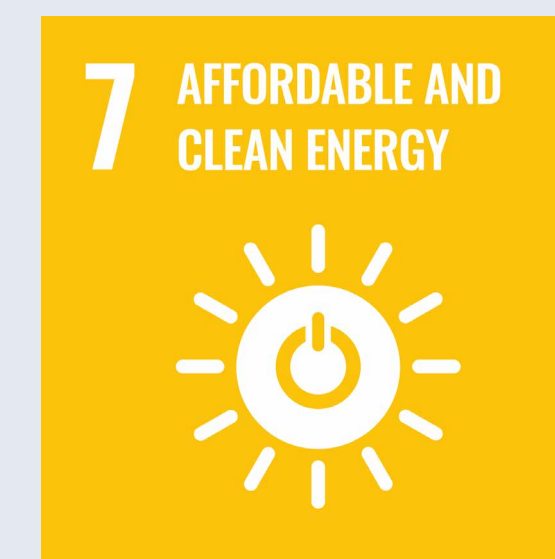

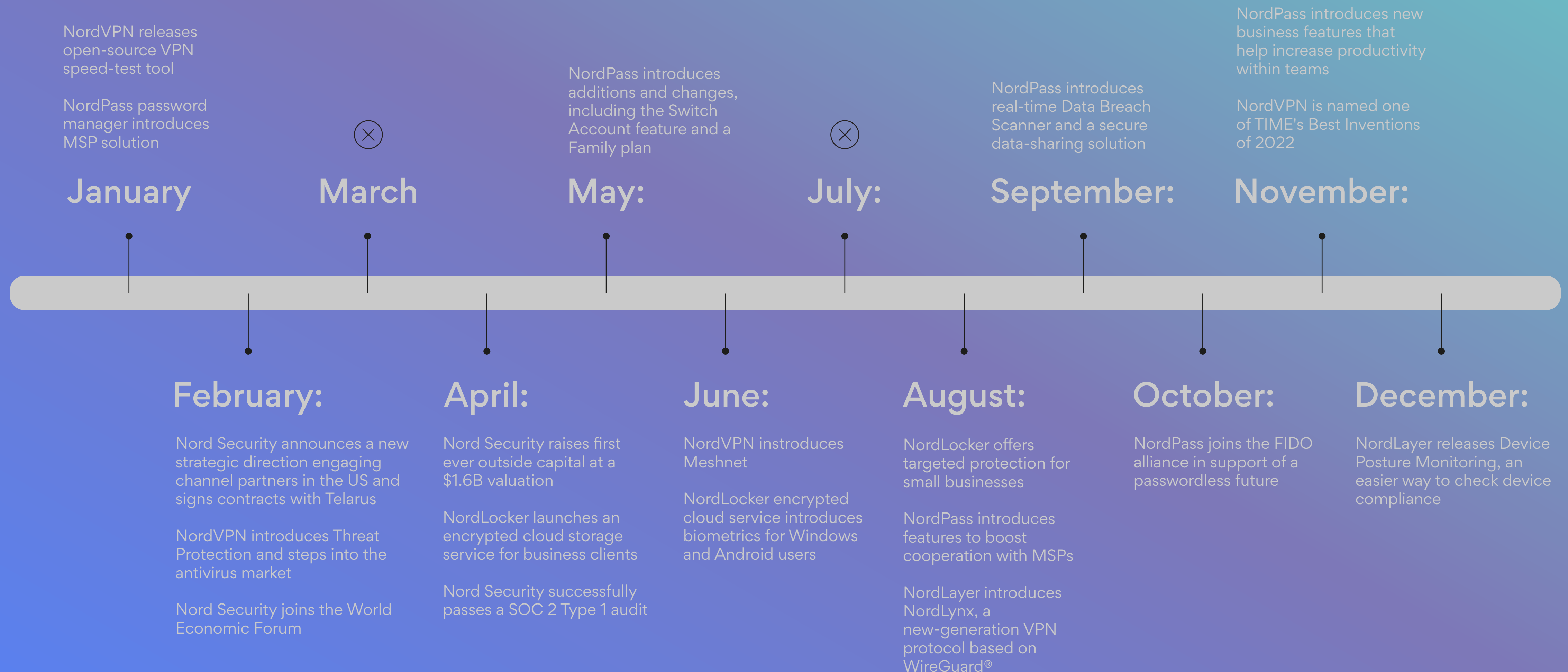

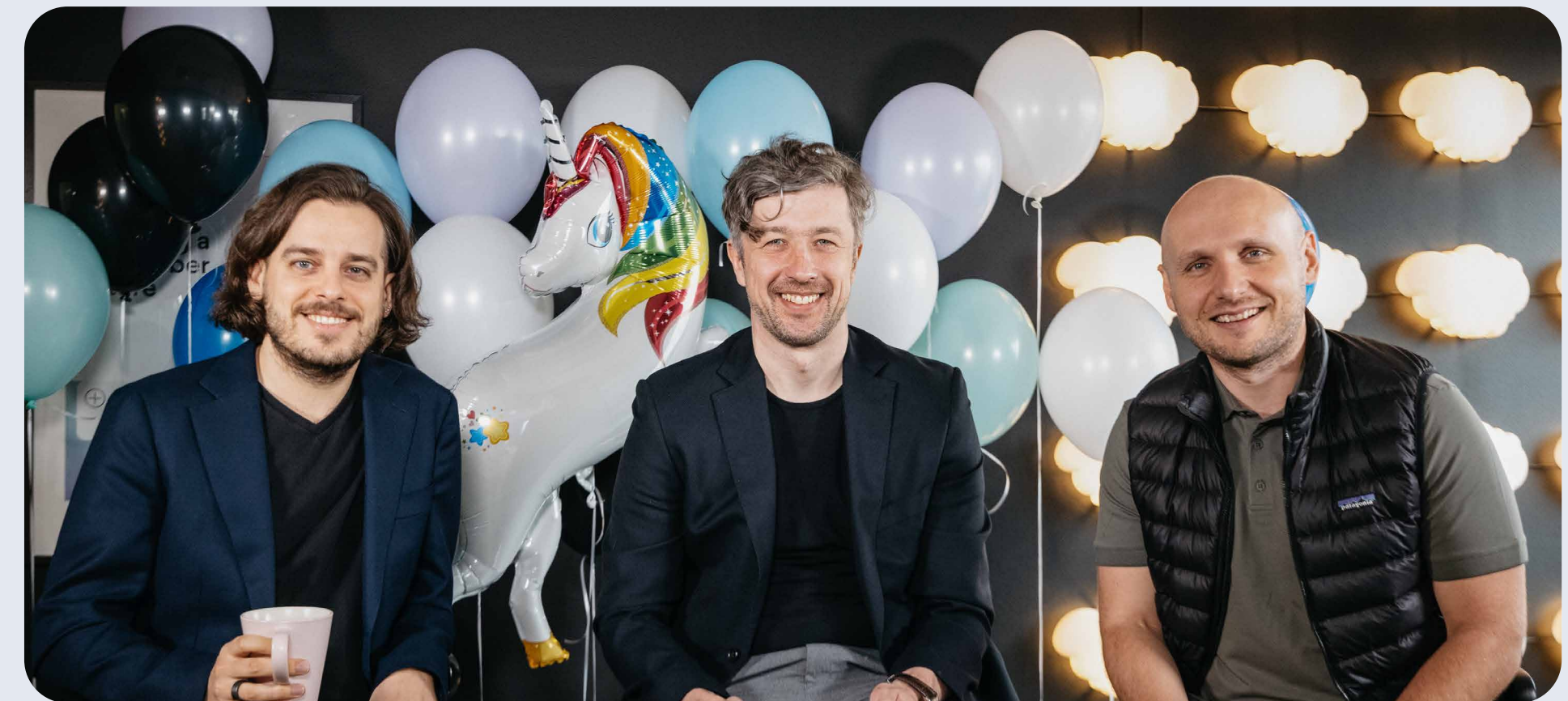
Insights of each brand



In 2022, we introduced multiple **new cybersecurity features** for our users, like Threat Protection and Meshnet. Industry experts recognized our determination to elevate the market, and NordVPN was even named one of **TIME's best inventions of 2022**.

In 2022, NordVPN continued to improve the user experience and released an open-source VPN speed-test tool. The tool accounts for a broad array of testing use cases, allows users to add and compare different VPN services, and provides detailed reporting.

We have invited other VPN service providers, researchers, journalists, and tech enthusiasts to participate in the ongoing development and refinement of this tool and methodology. In addition, we have written a detailed whitepaper to describe the methodology and provided the open-source code on GitHub. We believe that, when polished, it will provide an equal ground for everyone to measure and compare one of the most important VPN features and solve a problem that the entire industry is currently facing.

In 2022, NordVPN entered the antivirus market by launching Threat Protection. This feature, integrated into the NordVPN app, blocks ads, trackers, and malicious websites and scans suspicious files for malware during download. The addition of Threat Protection is part of a broader effort by NordVPN to shift into the cybersecurity space.

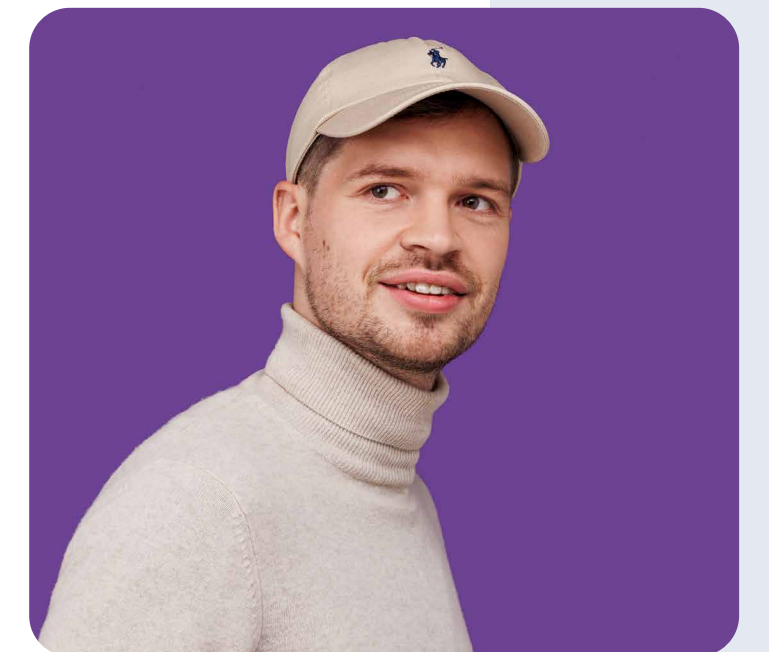
Introducing Meshnet

NordVPN introduced a feature that allows users to create their own VPN server in seconds. The feature lets users route their internet traffic through other devices over encrypted private tunnels

In 2022, our password manager implemented a series of new features and upgrades.

NordPass Business released **NordPass for MSP**, a password management solution that enables managed service providers (MSPs) to deliver a powerful and easy-to-use tool to their customers.

NordPass for MSP is a state-of-the-art solution that grants MSPs a full management option that allows them to manage and closely monitor multiple clients simultaneously from a single centralized admin panel. On the other end, MSP clients receive a powerful password management tool — NordPass Business — that significantly improves their overall security posture and in turn lowers the risk of data breaches.

NordPass Business also launched a new feature — **mandatory multi-factor authentication**. In addition to entering their email address and password, NordPass Business customers will need to verify their identity through an authenticator app.

NordPass Business also introduced **single sign-on (SSO) with Google Workspace**. Google Workspace SSO allows all employees of the organization to sign in to NordPass with their Google account. SSO is convenient and eliminates the need to create multiple accounts and passwords. This is beneficial because many people still create weak and easily guessable passwords.

In 2021, NordPass Business introduced the Activity Log feature. It provides a bird's-eye view of user activity in a company from one easy-to-use Admin Panel. In 2022, NordPass' **Activity Log got an upgrade**. Activity Log now includes details about Item Activities. The Item Activities provides an in-depth view of all item-related activities for factors like passwords, secure notes, and personal info.

NordPass' new feature **Switch Account** allows users to add up to five accounts and toggle between them without logging out. Previously, a user had to disconnect from one account before they were able to access another. This feature is also expected to serve users who have both NordPass business and personal accounts and are concerned about the privacy of their personal credentials.

NordPass has also introduced a **Family plan** that provides an end-to-end encrypted environment for storing and sharing passwords among family members. In total, six users can join one family account.



In 2022, NordLocker launched an **encrypted cloud storage service for business** — a business product to offer organizations around the world top-notch protection of their corporate data.

In 2022 NordLocker also introduced **biometrics for Windows and Android users** and launched an **encrypted cloud service** for business clients to offer them top-of-the-line protection, convenience, and cost-effectiveness when storing and managing their corporate data.

“Launching a business product is a big step for NordLocker. We are very happy about onboarding the corporate clients who’ve been with us all along and finally received a tailored solution to keep their business files secure in an even more convenient way.

“We introduced NordLocker as a robust file encryption tool in 2019. Since then, the product has undergone a few solid development phases and is now positioned as an end-to-end encrypted cloud storage option with a file encryption solution. It was only natural for us to move forward and launch an encrypted cloud service for business clients to offer a secure, convenient, and cost-effective way to store and manage their data.”

Last year brought more clarity to **NordLayer** both as a brand and service. The team behind the product took steps to focus more on the **Secure Service Edge** aspects within the Secure Access Service Edge (SASE) framework.

Activity monitoring was added to NordLayer, allowing network administrators to see who is using the service to secure a connection while accessing the public internet, SaaS applications, cloud environments, and on-premise resources and when they are doing so. **NordLynx**, a modern VPN protocol, introduced significant advances in terms of security and performance. Made from the ground up using NordVPN expertise, it expands the current tunneling protocols range now consisting of NordLynx, OpenVPN, and IPSec/IKEv2.

Other additions help organizations' network administrators by giving them more control over what content types can be accessed by their employees. The introduction of **Deep Packet Inspection and DNS Filtering** allows administrators to control access to a wide range of websites and applications listed in specific categories, such as gaming, gambling, or social networking.

Finally, **Device Posture Monitoring** was introduced to increase network security visibility, allowing administrators to check and evaluate devices according to predefined device posture rules and get notified about non-compliant devices.

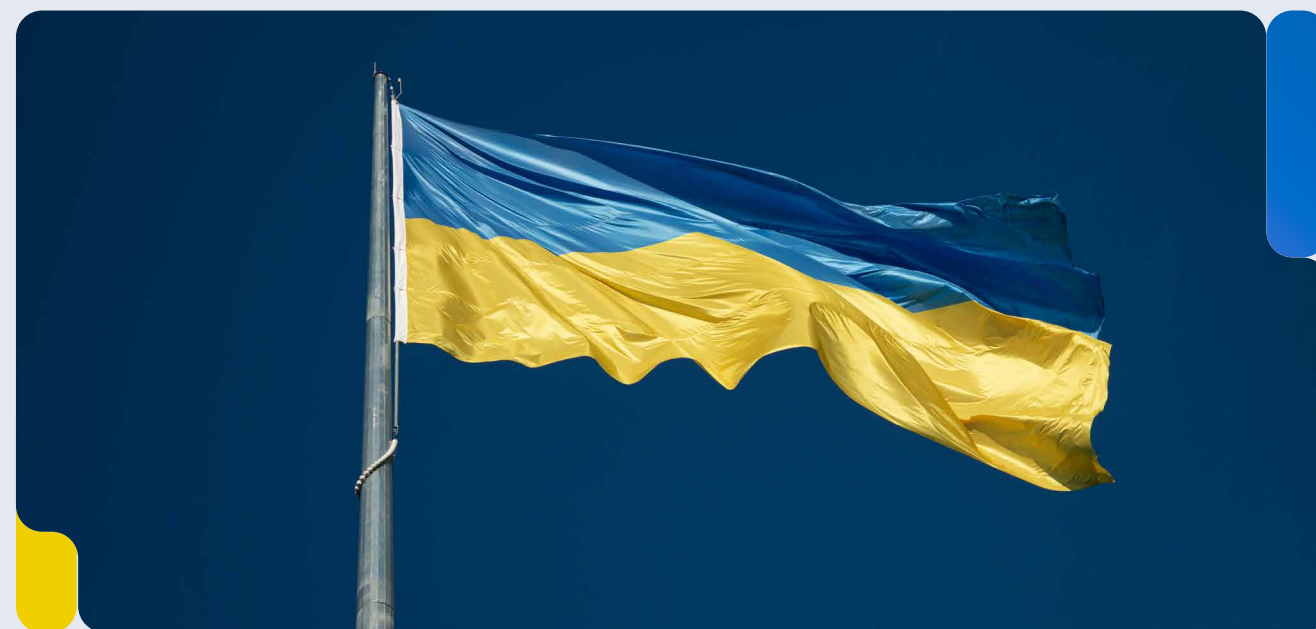


2022 spotlight: Nord Security's assistance to Ukraine

On February 24, 2022, war broke out in Eastern Europe after Russian troops invaded Ukraine. The news was shocking but simultaneously uniting. Various countries joined forces to help Ukraine fight for its freedom. Alongside military action, cyberwarfare has been used in an attempt to weaken and mislead people on the ground in Ukraine who are fighting for their lives.

Cyber education and other helpful action

With the growing number of incidents and the spread of disinformation, Nord Security dedicated efforts to help people and organizations to be aware of the threats and protect themselves better online. Our community also acted in the following ways:



- We donated over 900 Nord Security products to human rights activists, NGOs, and independent journalists. The aim was to help people spread and access credible information from global media outlets and share accurate information from the war in Ukraine. We continue with our donations, and the funds are available for people and organizations in need.
- NordVPN, in cooperation with other members of the VPN Trust Initiative, has taken steps to help VPN users by providing free VPN service to NGOs, journalists, and other vulnerable groups. It has also ensured access to Russians who want to circumvent state propaganda and sever business relations with Russian infrastructure providers without impacting user access.
- Almost 300 members of our community became volunteers. Experts chose to join different movements and organizations helping to support and strengthen Ukraine's position in the war.
- We've donated more than 30,000 EUR to NGOs like [Blue/Yellow](#) (aid is provided to the soldiers, volunteers, and territorial defense forces fighting for Ukraine's freedom) and [Maltieciai](#) (humanitarian help).
- We were also quick to provide a shorter employment cycle for talent from Ukraine. In total, 22 Ukrainians have joined the company since the war began.

We'll continue to be proactive in our approach to support people during the war in Ukraine.

Community engagement

Contributing to communities

In 2022, we continued to support communities by enhancing their freedom of speech and promoting global digital awareness through education.

Human rights

We stand for promoting equal opportunity in the digital age. We aim to see the internet the way it was first envisioned — free of crime, censorship, and surveillance. This vision is a fundamental part of our core values, and we honor this commitment in our policies and actions.

Support for non-profits

Product donations continue to be one of Nord Security's mechanisms for supporting the nonprofit community. In 2022, over 1,300 accounts were donated to various nonprofit organizations to help protect human rights, fight racism, and stand for inclusion and a safe digital world for all. These include Women Without Borders, the World Food Programme, Razom for Ukraine, the International Initiative for Mental Health Leadership, "Come Back Alive," the BC Community Alliance, and the Women Cybersecurity Society and many more.



Supporting free speech

Free speech is something that we often take for granted. It is also something that is widely debated and often controlled. Free speech isn't a liberty people have in many parts of the world, and when this right is imposed upon, it should be taken seriously. We create products and promote free speech through technology. Nord Security stands for digital freedom and helps people by securing their private data and providing open access to the internet.

Emergency VPNs

Everyone should be able to access the internet in private, without the fear of being watched or controlled. And yet too many people around the world live under heavy censorship and surveillance or are silenced for expressing their opinions.

In 2022, we donated **800+** emergency VPNs to help individuals in need (mainly people from Ukraine and Iran).

We provide employees with an internal mentorship program that offers an opportunity to learn from experienced professionals who share personal expertise, achievements, and challenges throughout their careers.

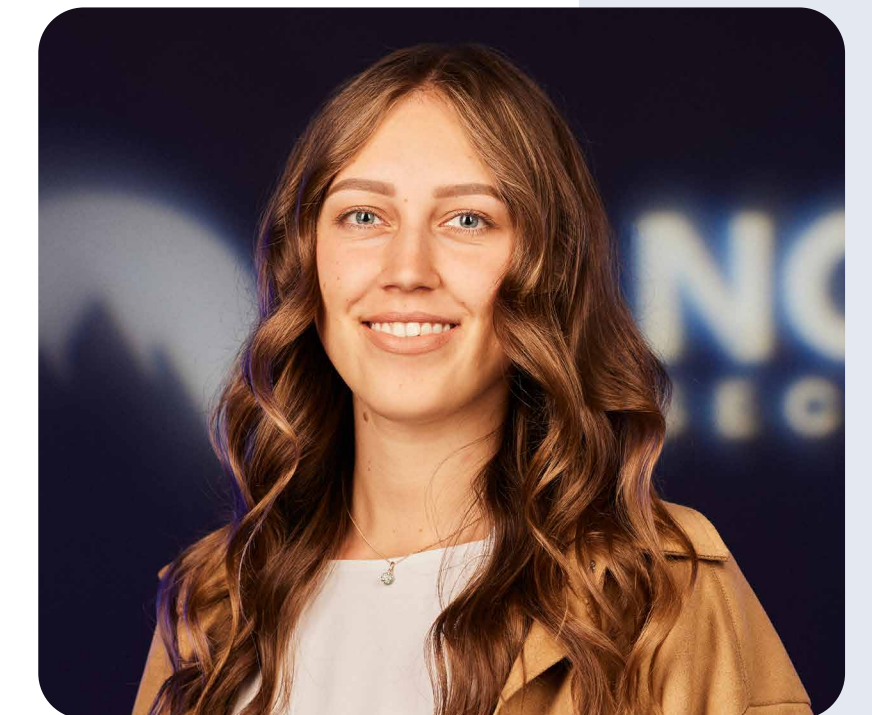
Library

Future shapers — always hungry for the next big thing. Pushing the boundaries and finding innovative solutions.

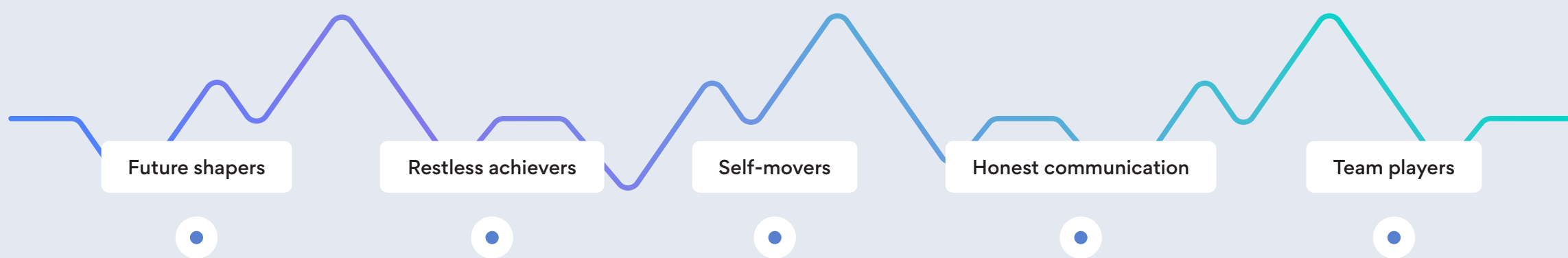

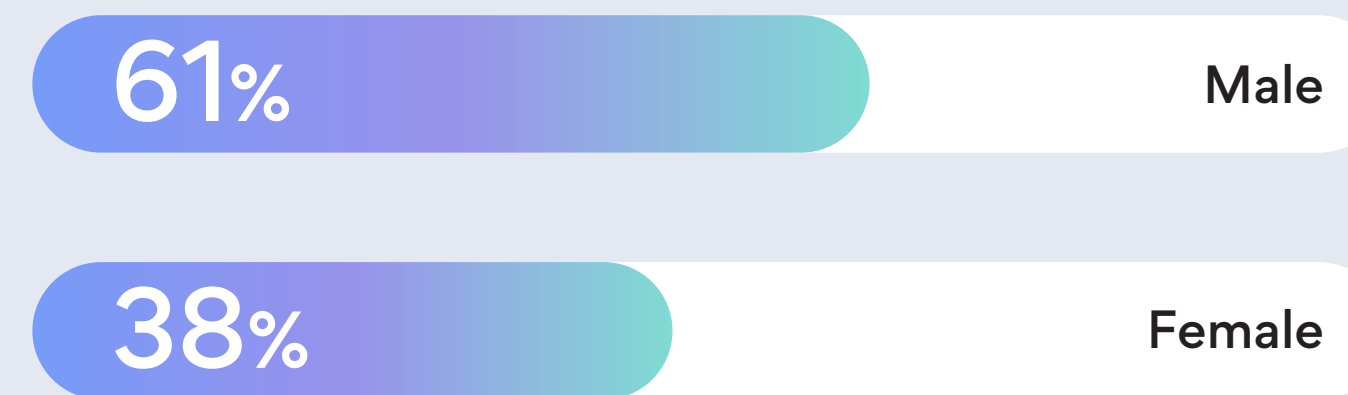
Diversity at Nord Security

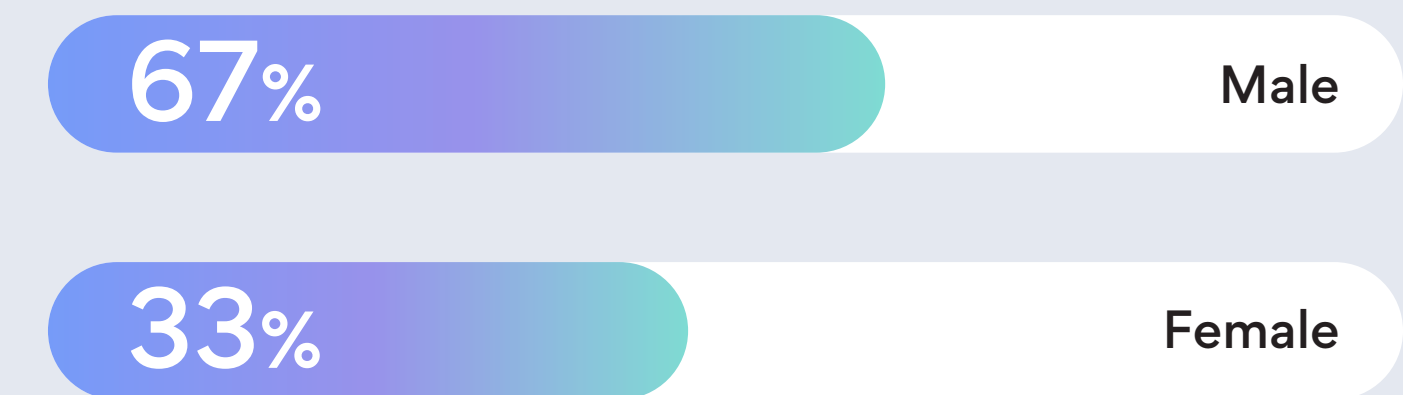

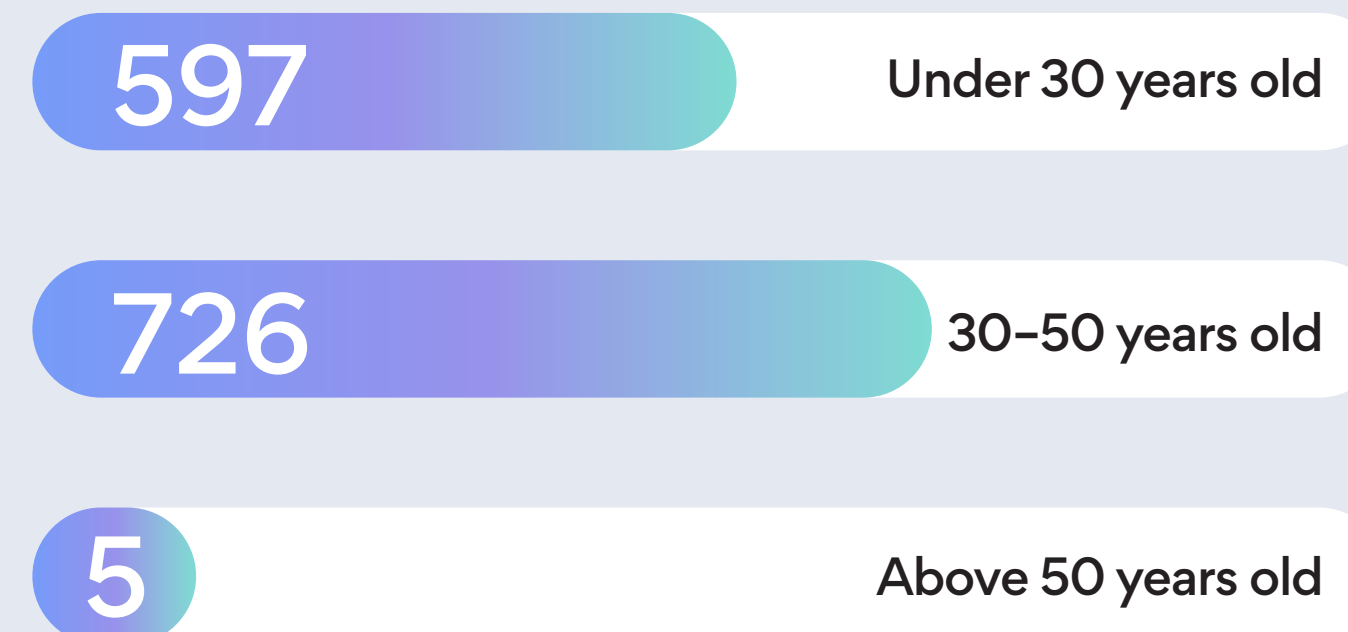
Percentage of employees by gender:

Health, safety & wellbeing

We are committed to a safe, healthy, and violence-free work environment. Behavior that poses a risk to the safety, health, or security of employees or visitors is prohibited.

Health check-ups onsite

We organize health checks and flu shots regularly to contribute to our employees' health.

Private health insurance

Private health insurance for all Nord Security employees is provided after their introductory probation period to ensure they have access to timely health check-ups and treatment. A selection of different plans is available depending on the individual's needs.

Physical wellness specialists

Several physiotherapists and trainers provide physical wellness consultations and workout sessions onsite and online. All employees can use their services during working hours.

Mental well-being

Emotional well-being is as important as staying fit and healthy physically. Nord Security's private health insurance covers up to 10 psychotherapy sessions for each employee. Three different premium apps providing meditation or emotional balance guidance are available as well.

Work-life balance

Flexibility is key at Nord Security. We value adaptable working arrangements — our employees have flexible working hours, can mix remote and onsite work, and are able to work from anywhere if needed.

Additional vacation days

We value loyalty. As a thank you, our employees get additional vacation days after spending more time at the company — one additional day after 1 year, two extra vacation days after 3 years, three extra days after 5 years, and four extra vacation days after 10 years at Nord Security.

Additionally, special occasions require uninterrupted time. That's why we offer paid days off for weddings, the birth of a child (for dads), and the start of the school year. The same goes for unfortunate life events — employees may use paid bereavement leave.

Additional payouts on special occasions

To support employees on their special days, we offer additional payouts on the occasion of work anniversaries, weddings, the birth of a child, graduation from college or university, and funerals.

Anti-corruption

Corporate governance, compliance

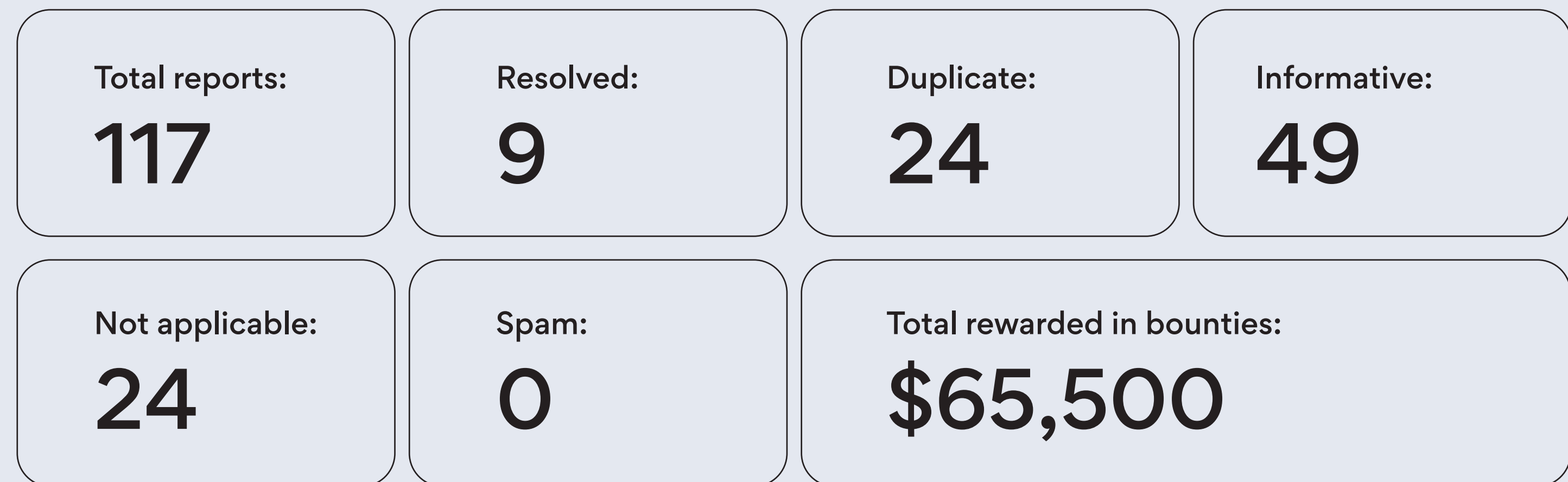

Nord Security is a member of several industry associations, including Computer & Communications Industry Association and I2Coalition, which help ensure that we not only stay up-to-date with changes in the regulatory landscape, but also become part of the debate on the upcoming legal framework for the cybersecurity industry.

Data Privacy and cybersecurity

A foundation of trust

Launched in 2019, our bug bounty program allows anyone to report bugs for a reward to further improve our service and help build a safer online world. Throughout 2021, we focused on attracting more people to submit quality reports to the program by increasing its scope and bounty ranges. During 2022, we improved the overall inside management process of reported vulnerabilities and/or bugs, which consequently allowed us to engage with more researchers. While we've noticed a significant increase in the reports' quality, we're looking forward to attracting more researchers to examine NordPass and NordLocker assets too.

Transparency

Security audits

Since 2019, security audits have been integral to our transparency measures. 2022 was no exception.

In 2022, NordVPN completed its most comprehensive security audit so far. It covered apps, the backend, and infrastructure. All vulnerabilities the process identified are already fixed, and retesting is projected to be completed in Q1, 2023.

NordLocker underwent an in-depth app security audit by NCC Group, global experts in information assurance and risk mitigation. We are proud to state that no critical or high vulnerabilities were found.

Nord Security successfully passed a SOC 2 Type 1 audit, indicating that the information security controls are in place to process users' data and protect the confidentiality and privacy of the information processed. Nord Security products — NordLayer, NordPass, and NordWL — have proved their success in managing users' data based on security, availability, processing integrity, confidentiality, and privacy.

Certifications

Meeting and exceeding industry standards is one of our key goals. Certifications help us measure these efforts and inform our users about improvements to our products.

NordLocker Business was certified as compliant with ISO27001. This certification ensures the continual improvement, development, and protection of information by implementation of appropriate risk assessments, appropriate policies, and controls.



VPN trust initiative

As founding members of the VPN Trust Initiative — an Internet Infrastructure Coalition project — we are dedicated to serving as the voice of the VPN industry, collaboratively strengthening public trust in VPNs, promoting appropriate guidelines, and helping consumers make informed VPN choices.

The Internet Infrastructure Coalition is on a mission to keep the internet open as an engine for growth and innovation. It works with internet infrastructure providers to advocate for sensible policies, design and reinforce best practices, help create industry standards, and build awareness of how the internet works. Therefore, by contributing to the VPN Trust Initiative project, we are also part of both following and setting appropriate industry standards.



Privacy

Nord Security adheres to data privacy regulations, including the guidelines set out in the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). When providing the services, Nord Security aims to ensure, among other things, lawful and transparent data processing and the implementation of proper security measures. Nord Security data processing activities are described in Privacy Policies which are publicly available at the websites of all Nord Security products.

Environmental impact

Nord Security understands the need to act in the environmental area of sustainable development and is looking for ways and methods to add to it. We start with small steps in our everyday activities.

Where it is in our power to do so, we will avoid or mitigate any harmful effects of our operations on the natural environment and resources.

Paper use

The company is almost paperless — paper is only used for a small percentage of documents, such as those required by local laws and regulations. This transition was achieved over the past two years with the introduction of safe and effective tools for signing agreements electronically and maintaining document databases (Dokobit, Docusign, Adobe).

In 2022, we also started using [FSC certified](#) paper for our packaged products.



Green workplace

More than a half of our premises have BREEAM certificates, which demonstrate the quality, performance, and sustainability credentials of the building.

E-waste

We partner with environmentally responsible IT asset Disposition Services to ensure that all regulations are adhered to. By doing so, we not only comply with all the relevant environmental laws and regulations but also ensure that these disposition services are making a difference in re-using parts of the disposed electronics and dispose of the unusable ones safely.

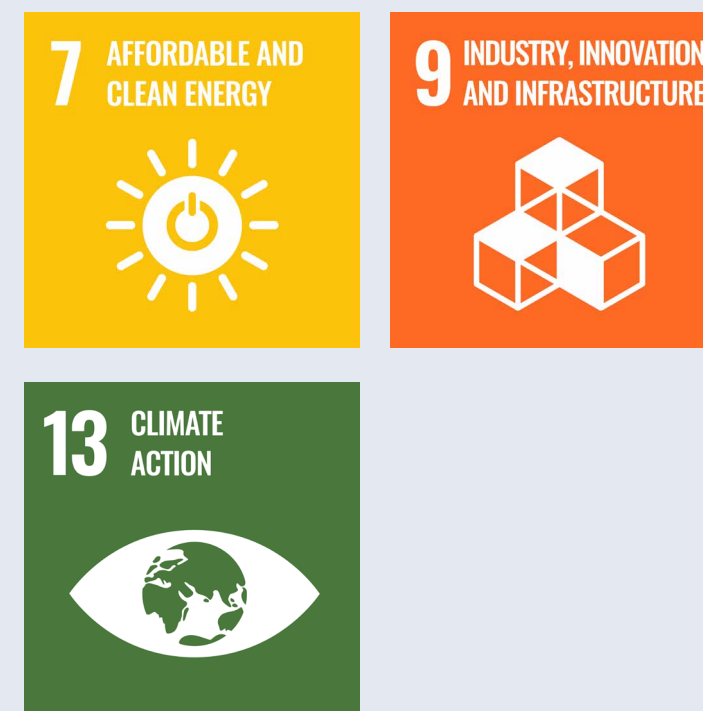
